

**PROJECT SYNDICATE:  
January 1, 2010 to January 1, 2011**

2010 was a year of slow recovery for the newspapers around the world. At the beginning of this period, Project Syndicate had 438 member newspapers in 150 countries, and as of January 1, 2011 Project Syndicate membership included 451 publications in 150 countries.

16 additional newspapers in developing and less developed countries received Project Syndicate editorial support in 2010, bringing the total to 247. Below, please see a list of Project Syndicate member papers in the developing world that joined during 2010.

**Project Syndicate Commentary Distribution**

In 2010, Project Syndicate distributed 770 commentaries, this is an increase of 18.5% from 2009. Furthermore, recognizing the need for diversity amongst its contributors and needing to cater to an ever growing global readership, Project Syndicate added eight new monthly commentary series, adding **Jagdish Bhagwati, Daniel Gros, Yuriko Koike, Jaswant Singh, Shashi Tharoor, Fan Gang, Jean Pisani-Ferry, Raghuram Rajan** to its list of monthly contributors.

In 2010, 20,768 Project Syndicate commentaries were published around the world. This is an increase of 20% from 2009.

## Project Syndicate Translations

In 2010, Project Syndicate continued providing translations of commentaries in nearly all major world languages. The table below shows the number of translated commentaries distributed in each language. Due to the financial crisis in 2009 Project Syndicate was forced to cut back on its translation service. However, we have continued translating nearly all content in areas of the world where access to ideas is most needed - specifically, French for Francophone Africa, Spanish for Central and South America, Chinese for China, Taiwan, and Hong Kong, and Arabic for the Near East.
